WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2018

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2018

- 11 am Silent Unity Prayer Service live-streamed from Unity Village at worlddayofprayer.org.
- 2:30 pm Music and spoken word to lift and release prayers of healing, live-streamed from Unity Village at worlddayofprayer.org.
- 7 pm Labyrinth Walk with Rev. Kurt at St. Scholastica, 7430 N. Ridge, Chicago, to mark the close of our prayer vigil by focusing on the prayer, "I am a healing presence," as we walk this beautiful site.
